



# Edinburgh






- Is the capital city of Scotland
- Is home to four universities and over **100,000 students**. Edinburgh is voted the "Best City in the World 2022" (Time Out 2022) and was named as the "Fourth most beautiful city in the world" (Rough Guide 2015)
- English is the official language
- Official population are approx. 500,000 inhabitants for the city of Edinburgh itself and 500,000 for the local authority area
- It is the largest financial centre in the UK after London

### How you can get to Edinburgh?





- Direct flights from Munich to Edinburgh
- Flight time is approx. 2 hours (Direct flight with easy-jet available)
- Alternatives: train, car, ferry

### Accommodation



- Four accommodation sites across the city
- Offering accommodations for over 1,200 students
- With rent from £110 per week
- All accommodations are selfcatered
- Situated in the centre of Edinburgh
- Private accommodation as an alternative

# In general: Cost of living above UK average

Experiences of LA students (Dec. 2018) Edinburgh Napier

- Market for accomodation is pretty packed LA students have good experiences to apply early for student accomodation or come for a couple of days during July / August to fix private accomodation
- Most times private accomodation goes through agencies
- Private shared rooms / appartments start by 600 GBP approx 800 GBP if central & higher standard
- Napier student accomodation starts by 450 GBP for a shared room (2 beds) and 600 GBP for a single room (Apply early!)

### **Timetable**



- 2 semesters per academic year (each 13 weeks + 2 weeks of exams)
  - September December
  - January May
- Bachelor thesis:
  - Hand-in date end of April,
  - Marking until end of May;
  - Graduation in June/July

  - Studium Generale (6 ECTS)
  - Dissertation (12 ECTS)
- Napier demands 60 ECTS points from Napier for double degree! According to Napier regulations!
- IMPORTANT: Napier will not steer the process that you select the RIGHT subjects concerning the requirements of HAW Landshut. It is in the individual resposibility of every student!
- For the double degree you have to fullfil requirements from 2 universities! More work ... but you receive 2 degrees.



What is the difference between a Bachelor and a Bachelor (Hons) degree?

- Joining the 3rd year: Bachelor degree (120 ECTS depending on an individual agreement 115 ECTS accepted to start with)
- Joining the 4th year: Bachelor (Hons) degree (150 ECTS depending on an individual agreement 145 ECTS accepted to start with)
- Upon individual agreements students can also join with 120 ECTS the final year and receive a Bachelor (Hons)
- From a German perspective the difference between a Bachelor and a Bachelor (Hons) is less relevant!





- Joining the 3rd year -> no thesis at Napier; Supervision of the thesis at Landshut (virtual supervision possible – you can start in parallel)
- One optional course must cover Financial Mgmt
- Students have to check back with Landshut administration if changes in curriculum occure during their year uproad



- BA (Hons) in Business Management
- Joining the 4th year! -> finally Bachelor with 240 ECTS
- Needs to have the permission to join into the last year (min 150 ECTS (resp. 145 upon individual arrangement) or 120 ECTS on individual arrangement)
- Napier Standard for the 4<sup>th</sup> year: 2 x10 ECTS courses per semester plus 20 ECTS Dissertation – spread across both semesters
  - Combination of lecture & self study time
  - Combination of written assignments, tests, presentations etc.
  - Academic standard high (very much recommended for everyone, wants to continue with a Master afterwards)
- PLUS: One additional 10 ECTS module to cover the HAW Landshut requirements; Landshut can just accept 12 ECTS for the Bachelor thesis;
- Fee for an additional module cannot be covered by the grant. Cost approx 310 GBP

# Courses BA (Hons) International Management Napier Edinburgh (joining 4th year)



2 optional courses:

- One optional course needs to fit to the HAW-LA module international mgmt
- One optional course has to fit to the HAW-LA module financial mgmt
- Course list might vary from semester to semester
- IMPORTANT: For BA (Hons) a minimum of 100 ECTS has to come for level 10 modules! (just one course can be a level 9 module)



### **Tuition fee**



- EU students beginning their studies after 1 August 2021 will be considered as overseas students for fee purposes
- Tuition fees 2023-24: approx. 14,170 GBP
- Scholarship of the University of Napier possible approx. 3,000 GBP
- Sum up: Fees approx. 11,336 GBP = <u>13,150 EUR</u>
- Bachelor: Thesis is written with HAW Landshut (no additional fees)
- Bachelor (Hons): In case one additional module has to be studied to get more ECTS due to max ECTS for Bachelor thesis in Bavaria -> PLUS 305 GBP tuition fee
