### Master International Business Entrance Requirement





**Bachelor's Degree** with **210 ECTS in business related field**. Applicants with 180 ECTS need professional working experience or additional academic experiences of a minimum of 900 hours in the field of business administration.



Language Requirement: C1-Level in English (IELTS score of 6.5, TOEFL score of 90 (with not lower than 20 in each category), TOEIC score of 465 for listening comprehension and 430 for reading). In case Bachelor's studies have been entirely taught in English, a respective confirmation issued by your university replaces a language test.



Applicants from a non-German-speaking educational institution have to **prove German Language skills** at the Level of A2 by the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.



Students with or without work experiences are accepted.

- Handling fee: € 75.00
- Result: Pre-test documentation (VDP)





### Apply via Primus Portal

- Relevant for all applicants
- Application Period from November 15 January 15
- Due to visa processes international students should apply as early as possible

Bachelor degree certificate and transcript of records

Secondary school final certificate

**Proof of English language skills (level C1 or equivalent)** 

If applicable: German language certificate (level A2 or equivalent)\*

If applicable: confirmation of practical / work experiences

\*Only for Graduates from non-German educational institutions
\*\*The recognition of degrees is a matter of the university





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
