GOAL

ENABLE INTERNATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL EXCHANGE VIA SHORT-TERM MOBILITY COMBINED WITH VIRTUAL, INTERNATIONAL TEACHING

### FRAME

- ✓ Short joint physical group mobility (5-30 days)
- Combined with virtual phase of undefined duration before, during or after mobility, collaborative online learning, exchange and teamwork;
- ✓ Minimum: 15 maximum 20 participants
- ✓ Minimum: 3 ECTS for students
- Minimum: 3 ECHE-HEIs from 3 different programme countries, other HEIs/organisations from programme or partner countries optional.
  The HEIs in partner countries (outside the Erasmus area) must have concluded an Inter-Institutional Agreement with Landshut University of Applied Sciences as the coordinationg HEI.

## PROCEDURE

- Request funding from the International Office (international\_office@haw-landshut.de, by 31<sup>st</sup> March annually)
- IO applies for mobility funding from 01<sup>st</sup> October (at the DAAD)
- ✓ After approval of funds: Coordination with IO rearding cost calculation, funding rates, steps to take with Finance

# PROCEDURE

- ✓ Further processing by IO and disbursement of funds prior to mobility via the Finance department.
- After the mobility, the Programme Officer submits a qualitative and quantitative report on the results of the BIP to the Erasmus+ Coordinator.
- Participants: submit participant reports in the relevant EU tool (link from International Office)

#### **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

- ✓ <u>Scholarship funds:</u>
  5-14 days = 70€/ day, 15-30 days = 50€/day
- ✓ In addition, TOP UPs for environmentally friendly travel and for persons with disadvantages as well as travel expenses.
- ✓ <u>Overhead-funds</u>: 400€ per participant Maximum amount: 8.000€
- ✓ Proof required
