Prerequisite:

- Study at a Bavarian state university/college/art college
- At least in the second semester
- Proven financial need (BAföG notification or means test)

Application process:

- Application at the beginning of the summer semester
- Online application form
- Documents to be submitted: Application form, certificate of enrolment, transcript of grades, list of learning materials, proof of financial need
- The university/college decides who will receive funding based on the budget allocation and the number of applicants; decisions may have to be made based on academic performance.
- Applicants receive approval, can purchase the learning materials and are reimbursed by the university/college.

What does the foundation offer?

- Funding for learning materials (books, tablets, notebooks, etc.) up to €500 once per bachelor's degree programme and per master's degree programme

- Application portfolio (expert opinion from a professor, confirmation of voluntary work, CV, transcript of grades) must be submitted by lecturers to the International Office by 18 August of the respective year
- Selection is made by a committee consisting of the president and representatives of the International Office

Requirements:

- Students from Eastern Europe (Albania, Baltic States, Belarus, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Kosovo, Croatia, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Czechia, Ukraine, Hungary)
- Financial hardship through no fault of your own (e.g. due to illness or accidents) or a decisive phase in your studies (e.g. graduation)
- First degree
- Maximum age of 35
- Maximum 15th semester
- No entitlement to other forms of financial support (exclusion of possible double funding)

Application process:

- Usually three months of financial support (six months in exceptional cases)
- Max. £400 per month / max. £500 per month for students with children

Requirements:

- Monthly rent must be higher than the estimated rent amount in the living expenses
- Consultation with the immigration authorities is necessary to ensure that the residence permit is not jeopardised

- Apply online or in paper form at the housing benefit office of the city of Landshut or the Landshut district office
- Advice Student Life provides support with the application process
