- 2,6 - 3,5 = Satisfactory
- 3,6 - 4,0 = Adequate
- e = Taken with success
- 5,0 / 5,0- = 1st try not passed / not taken. Exam has to be repeated within 6 months.
- 6,0A / 6,0B / 6,0- = 2nd try (1st repetition) not passed / not taken / 3rd try (2nd repetition) not passed, 4rd try authorised. Exam has to be repeated within 12 months / if the fourth attempt is repeated within 6 months.
- 7,0 / 7,0- = 3rd try (2nd repetition) not passed / not taken. A 3rd repetition is not allowed. The exam is finally failed, with the consequence of exmatriculation.
